Forewords



Mr. Masakazu TOKURA Chair of Japan Committee for the UN Decade on Biodiversity (UNDB-J) (Chairman of Japan Business Federation)

Since its establishment in 2011, the Japan Committee for the UN Decade on Biodiversity (UNDB-J) has been engaged in a wide range of activities to achieve the Aichi Targets in cooperation with all stakeholders in Japan, including the national government, local governments, businesses, civil society organizations, and others, in order to promote the conservation and sustainable use of biological diversity. In the past decade, with the cooperation and efforts of UNDB-J's member and supporters, mainstreaming of Japanese biodiversity has made steady progress. The Japan Council for the Realization of the 2030 Framework for Sustainable Development (J-GBF), established in November 2021 as a successor organization, will play a central role in building further cooperation among stakeholders and promoting further behavioral changes of society as a whole to achieve the Post-2020 Biodiversity Framework and the national biodiversity strategy and action plans. We would like to ask for your continued understanding and cooperation.

Achievement and Future Challenge

(1) Lessen learned and challenges

In UNDB-J, the roadmap formulated based on the mid-term evaluation shared the vision of the society to be attained, and each organization was able to proceed with their initiatives. Some of the initiatives were effective and require continuation, while others require improvement. In addition, some companies actively funded such activities over a long period of time.

UNDB-J, a platform for diverse actors to participate, has helped to deepen mutual understanding through inter-sectoral collaboration and cooperation, and has also led to the expansion of voluntary initiatives. In addition, there has been progress in the content of each initiative over the past 10 years, and the fact that these achievements have been communicated and recognized internationally is a significant accomplishment. On the other hand, collaboration with organizations that do not participate in UNDB-J has not been sufficient. As the core organization of the country, it is essential for the Committee to further expand collaboration.

(2) Toward the Realization of a Living in Harmony with Nature - Connections for the Next Generation / Expectations for the Next Generation

Since biodiversity is related to all human activities, it is important for more and more entities to deepen mutual understanding and voluntarily engage in biodiversity-conscious activities in cooperation and collaboration with various sectors.

Mainstreaming biodiversity" continues to be an important theme in international discussions toward the Post-2020 Biodiversity Framework, a new international biodiversity goal. While UNDB-J has focused on raising awareness and promoting initiatives by its member organizations, it is expected to create a platform that can encourage individual companies and individuals other than its member organizations to take action in the future. It is also important to take the viewpoint that further promotion of biodiversity initiatives will lead to contributions to the various goals of the SDGs, as it is required to contribute to solving various social issues through biodiversity initiatives.

United Nations Decade on Biodiversity


The United Nations General Assembly decided 2011-2020 as the "UN Decade on Biodiversity".




Each citizen selects an action from among five actions and makes a "MY Action Declaration" so that each citizen can see the relationship with biodiversity in his/her own life.

Accreditation of Collaborative Projects

In addition to the projects registered in the "Nijyumaru Project," the UNDB-J will certify collaborative projects from among the related projects of UNDB-J member organizations and related ministries and agencies (registered in the "Nijyumaru Project" after the certification).

Once certified...

Certified collaborative projects are introduced on the UNDB-J website, in the public relations magazine "Iki Tomo", press releases, National Biodiversity Meetings, regional biodiversity seminars, etc., and the UNDB-J logo is used on the brochure and website.









Selection and donation of Recommended Books "Biodiversity of the bookcase"

In March 2013, UNDB-J selected "Books for Children" (nicknamed "Biodiversity of the Bookcase" - 100 books to connect everyone with living things), which is recommended by UNDB-J. UNDB-J has been actively promoting the selection of books that contribute to the understanding and promotion of biodiversity and to environmental education.



Keidanren Council for Nature Conservation and other companies donated 58 sets, at least one in each of the 47 prefectures in Japan with corporate support.







Green Wave



Children around the world plant trees, etc. at schools and local communities to spread the "Green Wave" around the world on the International Day for Biological Diversity (May 22), as called for by the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity. UNDB-J, together with the Ministry of the Environment, the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, called for participation in Green Wave activities from March 1 to June 15 every year.






Official Partners

Starting in 2018, the appointment of "Green Wave" Official Partners was implemented and 13 organizations were appointed as partners; from 2018 to 2020, activities were promoted mainly by the partners.

10-year results

From 2011 to 2020, the cumulative number of participating organizations reached 3,374, the cumulative number of participants reached approximately 260,000, and the cumulative number of trees planted reached approximately 330,000.

To promote the "United Nations Decade on Biodiversity" (UNDB) and call for action to achieve the Aichi Targets, the Ministry of the Environment, UNDB-J, and the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) organized a day-long event COP12 in Pyongchang, Korea; COP13 in Cancun, Mexico; COP14 in Egypt, Sharm El Sheikh. We supported Japanese youthto participate in the meeting of CBD; since 2016, a total of 10 people have participated in COPs and preparatory meetings. They reported about discussions at international conferences.



Establishment of J-GBF

In order to conserve biodiversity, which is the foundation of human life, we must not only protect the natural environment in place, but the entire society that benefits from biodiversity must understand the value of biodiversity and take action to protect it. The United Nations Decade on Biodiversity (2011-2020) has been working as the Japan Committee for the United Nations Decade on Biodiversity (UNDB-J) to achieve the Aichi Targets and mainstream biodiversity.


In order to achieve the next international targets and national strategies such as the Post-2020 Biodiversity Framework, including the 30 by 30 targets, the Japan Committee for the United Nations Decade on Biodiversity (UNDB-J) has been established to promote participation and collaboration among all sectors in Japan, including the national government,

local governments, businesses, citizens, NGOs and youth, and to promote efforts for the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity. The Japan Council for the Realization of the 2030 Biodiversity Framework (J-GBF) was established in November 2021 as the successor organization to UNDB-J.
